Dear family and friends,

October 29, 2019

We pray this short update and photos finds you well. Miraculously the violent unrest in Ecuador has calmed with the president forming new agreements concerning subsidizing petrol. The situation certainly had us, and keeps us, on our knees as does now the unrest in Chile and other places nearby.

As soon as we could use public transport and the roads cleared once again, we travelled to the printer who had just completed and had packed the 8,000 Christmas tracts for us to pick up.

More than ever the public need some cheer, so we have already begun with distribution of these tracts, (see photo) the content of which emphasizes the values regarding the best kind of gifts one can give...kindness, selflessness, etc. in this heavily populated, and troubled city, Quito. (the Capital of Ecuador). We await the delivery of the rest of the publications...but what we have already on hand will keep us busy until Christmas. Already 1,000 gospel tracts have been distributed.

We also continue following up and strengthening converts...usually in their place of work as many are busy 7 days a week..with work and family commitments. We thank you for your support in prayers and gifts to help us with living and travelling costs. We found some donors to help cover the cost of printing, which already our dear printer JAIME, reduces greatly

Miraculously our printer friend had finished the first batch of Christmas message tracts colour and his print shop was not vandalized...our neighbourhood was threatened by armed vandals, but the neighbourhood committee formed a strategy which alarmed the vandals...the wild west....we stayed inside and prayed!! So today we went to pick up 8,000 tracts. He will continue the printing project of various titles for our Rescuing Values Project...we pray that the calm will last...we need time to get back on our feet and get out on the move again,

As far as we know, there are no camps or shelters set up in Ecuador..so the refugees are left to beg, sell cookies and candies..families with children sitting in the shade begging from passers by living on the street and in parks and industrial areas...It is an overwhelming situation... and we try to give when and where we can..sometimes food, sometimes clothes, sometimes a few coins..and always the prayer of salvation...which they gladly receive.

The photos were taken during a holiday weekend in the biggest park in Quito. Families come out to spend time together, street vendors also and the park becomes a hub for selling wares and snacks, and lunches.....

We have just about finished selecting the articles to print for our next project, reaching children and students as well as the general public.

Venezuelan refuges arriving in Ecuador.

Almost 1.2 million Venezuelans have entered Ecuador since 2015. most of whom have travelled onward to Peru or other third countries. However, there are now some 221,000 Venezuelan refugees and migrants remaining in Ecuador, and increasing numbers are choosing to stay. The arrival of so many in a short period of time has strained Ecuador's institutional capacity. Many Venezuelans lack access to social services, including health, education, housing, and livelihoods. As more Venezuelans with increasingly acute needs arrive and choose to stay, Ecuador is struggling to respond.
