Almost by accident or opportunity, I became involved with writing very short comments on a few on line newspaper articles. The door to post these comments is free for the general public, so over the last ten years, or so, I have made at the time of this edition, 274 comments on articles published via a 'popular' newspaper in the UK, called the Daily Mail. That's only about 27 comments a year! Not many, by any means!

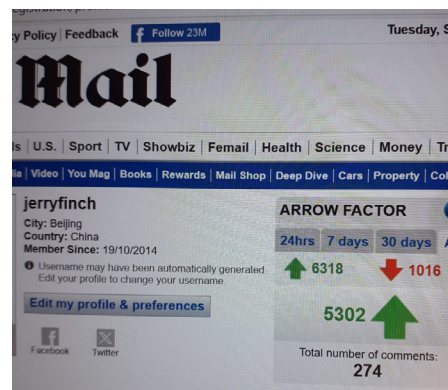
I did this originally just for fun, but after a short while I realised, 'hey! This is a

good opportunity to witness for God or at the very least speak righteousness into this nation!

Let me explain:

So this newspaper produces a lot of articles each day, the vast majority of them are garbage, trash and worldly beyond belief. But there are a few, precious few, which address very important things happening in the world and deciding what is true and false about various famous people or political events, social events, personal hardships etc.

So I began very slowly posting a sentence or two comments on a few articles. What happens then is that your comment gets 'liked' or 'disliked' (green or red arrows, see below).



I didn't know this at the beginning. As I slowly learnt about this situation I began to pray more to write something from God, and not just my own thinking.

I discovered the following valuable

things, especially over the last few years which are:

1. Most people seem to respond quite well to a righteous opinion based on God's Word, although I don't always say that my comment it is from God's Word.
2. Articles and Comments are 'hot' in the public mind, and only last for a very limited time. Your feedback is only going to last 2-3 days max.

3. ANYTHING I WRITE CRITICISING ANY FEMINIST MINDSET, IS GREETED WITH WAVES OF RED ARROWS, HA!

4. EVEN WHEN I MENTION JESUS CHRIST, I GET THE SAME REACTION! That was a surprise initially. The readership is primarily UK-based I feel. This is why i believe the UK is

not going to repent and become a Christian nation again, as I wrote previously.

5. The Lord has shown me to speak a Word or comment that is based on the Bible or is reflective of what I think God's perspective to be.
6. I don't care about red arrows, only about if I say the right thing! I don't feel the Lord will bless this effort if I try to please man or woman!

So as you will, the vast majority of my comments are well received, with a smaller minority of around 16-18% hostile (red).

I thank God for that. Jeremiah in the Bible got way more red arrows than I do, after whom I am named!

I have received 6,318 'likes' of my 274 comments, and 1,016 dislikes!

I don't do this every day, but I have now realised this is a form of ministry which only takes me about 20 minutes a week!

So that is my tiny teensy-weensy ministry, or like a ministry. Who knows what God will make of it eventually? I am praying to be faithful and speak the Truth INTO A NATION! That's really what we should all be doing in some way, shape or form! Praise the Lord.

I am not saying you should do this, but you could. However more importantly you could pray what are the talents you have been given by God and what could you do for His Glory with those talents?

God pours out to each of His saved children, talents and gifts, please take those gifts and pray about them, and see if God will not abundantly bless you for it. He surely will. Amen?
