I SAW A BOY. PART I

Today I saw a boy. Perhaps he was about 14, that's what I initially thought, but I suppose he could have been 15 or even as much as 16 years old, although I don't really think he could be that old.

He was sitting on a bench in a small park. This park was rectangular. It wasn't very big, **perhaps** 200 metres long by about 100 metres wide. It is called 'St. George's park'. I pass it often. It's just off the main highway (**main road around the town in England-speak**).

I live in a town called Kidderminster, England. This is a relatively large town on the edge, of the 'Black Country', a part of England which has been the most receptive to the Gospel of Jesus Christ in the last two hundred years. Not the only place of course, there are literally hundreds of towns in England, Wales, Scotland and the two Irelands who hungrily received the gospel, in many centuries past.

As I write this message, the winter sun suddenly shines dazzlingly bright through our kitchen windows, which face towards the south! I have now had to turn off all the lights in the downstairs part of our building as the Light is so bright. God is saving me money on the electrics, and He can do the same for you! Nature has a power all of its own, praise the Lord.

I was driving. The traffic was quite fast, as I looked to my left towards the park, as I often to do, I saw this



young boy; he was sitting there on a park bench. He was sitting very still. His head and body faced forward. He had no emotion, as far as I could see, except I had the strong sense he was deeply troubled. My heart moved deeply for him at this moment, and I began to pray for him.

Why was this young teenage boy sitting alone in an empty park at about 10.15 in the morning? He was not at school, yet it was not a holiday time. He was completely by himself. Surely he was of school age?

I prayed for him, as I very often do when I see a young person, that he would find Jesus, if not already, and become a missionary. I do this frequently, in the confidence that God will answer my prayer!

I was a boy once, now I am 71 and soon to be 72. But I remember a lot about being a boy, some good and some bad. I remember both joys and gladness and sorrow and pain. I remember relatives, school friends and teachers, the huge dentist with the very hairy hands, one of which he stuck in my mouth to pull out a stubborn tooth. I felt half my teenage jaw was going to break. I never returned to a dentist for over 30 years after that.

Yes, being a boy is a good thing it's a truly wonderful thing, especially if sometime during that time period

between 5 and 16 that you find the Lord (Jesus). If you are a boy, and you **don't** find Jesus during that time, then life in today's feminised world can be very difficult for you, **my dear spiritual and beloved masculine 'son'.**

So, I saw a boy, just for a few seconds and so much symbolism hit me, of how important it is NOW to reach 'boys', young men and even older men with Jesus' Love, or what is sometimes called 'The Gospel'.

I began to be greatly moved by the Holy Spirit, just by the position of his body and the blank, empty or distraught face he seemed to have. I was in the wrong traffic lane to get over to the exit of 'his' roundabout, and so I kept driving, onwards towards my own home. I regret that. I should have gone back and found a way to get into that park and greet him. May the Lord forgive me.

There is hope.

What will happen to our boys and our sons and grandsons who grow up now in this generation? Unless they know and love Jesus and have a warm close bond with true Christian mentors, their outlook in the ungodly world appears slim.

I encourage you dearest friends, to pray for boys, teens and men this year. Go out and reach them for Jesus, or be aware of them when you go out. Perhaps many of you know that men and young men

have the highest suicide rates in the western world? They grow up in many cases without moorings. (Links below).

Prayer can change things.

Nearly all the homeless in our city are young men in their late teens or early twenties or older men. My 13 year-old son and I sometimes meet them on the days when we go into the local large town to do our shopping, we usually share a gospel tract or talk with them or give them some coin change.

So that is part of my own personal New Year message for you, our dear friends. **Please pray for them. Please ask God how He can use you to help them and be aware of them wherever you go.**

You may also have some boys or teens, men who you have a spiritual burden for in your churches. You may also have sons and grandsons yourselves. Prayer can change all things. Bind up the powers of the enemy of God's people through your prayers. Cast down every 'imagination' (mindset), that is hurting God's boys and young men. Let's unitedly pray together this year for a great global harvest in Jesus, of the male race/gender, so that they can grow up and bear fruit for God. Time is short! 2 Corinthians 10:5

Children are a mission field in themselves!

In so many countries of the world today, their greatest problem is their children. What nations fail to realise is that the world of tomorrow is what the adults of today make it, according to what they choose to give or not to give to the next generation. Capture the youth, (for Christ), and you have conquered the future!

"Train up a child in the way he should go.", the Bible says., and "when he is old, he will not depart from it." Proverbs 22:6. We, as believers in Jesus, should mould their minds and educate them and encourage them, and most of all, we really need to build their faith.

Children are the most sincere people in the world. They are also at the age of malleability, when they can still be bent and moulded. It's an age of choice, an age of decision. It takes time and patience and understanding and lots of real love to reach them, but that's actually when most people accept the Lord.

"Open the door for the children; tenderly gather them in, in from the highways and hedges, in from the fields of sin. Open the door for the children, tenderly gather them in." For of such is the Kingdom of God. (Mark 10:14)
